

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
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

# 1.2. Paper weight / quality

Use suitable sheet which weight is 120 to 400gsm (0.12 – 0.4mm).


Notes: Some workpieces may not be cut even within this range.

These sheets are not suitable in use.

- Sheets that have heavily static charged. It may cause miss-feed, double feed or paper iam.
- Sheets that are more than 3mm curled. It may cause miss-feed, double feed or paper jam.
- Weak stiffness sheet. It may cause miss-feed, double feed or paper jam.
- Hard stiffness sheet. It may cause cut defects.
- Sheets that have ink or toner not fused properly. It may cause contaminating the work and the machine.
- Sheets that are too slippery. It may cause miss-feed or inaccurate results.
- Prints that are shrank, stretched or skewed inconsistently. It may cause inaccurate results.

# 2.1. Turning the power on




#### 2.2. Initial setting

- ① After turning on the power , INITIAL SETTING is displayed on the Home screen.
- 2 Press INITIAL SETTING.
- ③ Initial setting starts by automatically.
  - Press roller moves to Home position.
  - · Hold to up the Die board.
- ④ After initial setting is completed , SET UP or START is displayed on the Home screen.








① Input the number of sheets and sets.

All the sheets on the feed table will feed in case 0 is entered in Quantity.



- Feed table goes down. when it reaches the bottom, it automatically stops and changes to the START display.




④ Flip through the sheets well before you put them on the feed table.









- It affects finishing accuracy if there is a gap between the side guide and the sheets.









# 2.5. Check the condition of the Press plate


- · Clean the Press plate and Base plate with a parts cleaner before starting work one day.
- After cleaner, wipe them with a cloth soaked in oil (machine oil) and refuel.



Note.

Insufficient lubricant will lead to increased wear and ultimately failure. Keep the paper carrying belt without oil.

• Do not place anything on the Press plate as it may cause a malfunction.



① Press START to start an automatic operation. The display will change to RUNNING .

② After processing the entered number of sheets in QUANTITY, the machine stops automatically.


# 2.7. Interruption

- Press STOP and the machine will make an EMERGENCY stop even if the operation is underway.
- Press END if you wish to stop the machine when the current sheet is completed.


- PROCESS SHEET indicates the number of finished sheet when the machine is stopped with STOP or END button.

1	The level of pressurization on the opposite side press roller.  Input the level after pressure adjustment.		
2	The level of pressurization on the operation side press roller.  Input the level after pressure adjustment.		
3	The counter the Die board has been used for each saved data.  Counts up with every pressurization.		
4	Position of the blade on the Die board.  Input the dimension from the left edge of the Die board to the blade.		
5	Printing position. Input only when cut marks are nothing.  Input the dimensions from the edge of the paper to the left edge of the job design.		
6	Printing position. Input when cut marks are on.  Input the dimensions from the edge of the cut mark position to the left edge of the job design.		
7	Paper size.		
8 9 10 11	The number of times for multifaceted control.  Input the pitch in the range from 0.001 to paper length in divided by the number of pitch repeats.  Even if enter the number of times for the pitch that has nothing to do with the number, it does not affect the operation.




① Press OK when the changes are complete. If there are any change confirmation screen will be displayed.

    - Job no and Job name change to automatically, and move to the home screen.




- Recommend that try to the test and save the data if there is no defect.







# 4. Die board setting

# 4.1. Die board Changing

- ① Remove the two knobs.
- ② Slide the Press plate into the Plate holder.




③ Remove the Protective plate and put on the Plate holder.




4 Remove the set Die board.

- 5 Slide to the front the Cutting plate.
- 6 Remove the set one and attach a new Cutting plate.



Make sure that the film at the edge of the "Scratch prevention plate" is on top of the "Cutting plate". If the film goes under the "Cutting plate", it may cause a paper jam.




7 Make sure that it is firmly seated on the locating pin.






The cutting plate may warp with continue to used. If the paper jam due to warpage, use the attached Countersunk head screw to increase the fixing points.

Clean it so that no dust such as paper dust remains under the cutting plate, it may cause reduce the cutting quality.




- 8 Set a new Die board.
- Set the Die board is under the left and right metal fittings.







Set the Die board by pressing it firmly to the left opposite.



Tighten the blade die fixing knob to prevent the blade die from tilting.





- Reattach to the Protective plate.
- ① Reattach to the Press plate.

#### Note.


Depending on the shape of the Die board, it may not be held down by the holding metal fittings and the Press plate may rise.

Floating of the Press plate may cause malfunction. If the Press plate is floating, increase the fixing points with the attached Hexagon socket head cap screw and fix it.


Do not place anything on the Press plate as it may cause a malfunction.

#### 4.2. Adjustment of the level of pressurization

- 1 Loosen the Clamp lever.
- 2 Turn the level of pressurization to 0.
- 3 Tighten the Clamp lever.



- 4 Set the Die board and cut it.
- Depending on the design of the Die board, the finish may differ depending on the direction in which the Press roller moves. Check both cut samples of "left to right" and "right to left" operation of the press roller.
- 5 Check the cut samples.
- If the press of pressurization is too much, adjust the dial in the "-" direction to reduce the pressure.
- If the press of pressurization is not enough, adjust the dial in the "+" direction to reduce the pressure.
- Scale:+1= 0.0394" down, -1 = 0.0394" up




- Adjust the part that is not partly with the "unevenness removal" of the Die board.
- Once again, process it and check the condition, and if there is no problem, it is completed.
- Recommend to save the data of pressurization level for the next time. Input the value in the saved data and overwrite.







Operable functions change depending on the position of the Die board.









# 6.1.1.Speed

#### Belt speed

- The feeding speed of the Paper carrying belt can be changed in 5 steps.
- 5 is default setting.




#### ♦ Press speed


- The Pressing speed of the Press roller can be changed in 3 steps.
- 3 is default setting.
- If feel the vibration of the Press roller movement is bigger, down the speed.



#### 6.1.2.Double feed check

- Ultra-sonic double feed detection
- The ultra-sonic sensor detects multi-layered sheet and prevents double feed.
- By pressing the button shown on the right image, the ultra-sonic sensor can be activated / deactivated.
- · Some paper may react incorrectly.
  - $\Rightarrow$  Turn it OFF.
- ◆ Transmissive double feed detection
- The transmissive sensor detects the transmittance and prevents double feed.
- The sensitivity of the transmissive sensor can be adjusted by pressing the button shown on the right image.
- · MEDIUM SENS is default setting.
- Do not print on the inspection position (edge of paper)of the transmission sensor.
- The transmission sensor does not respond normally to paper (thick paper, black paper, and dense paper). that does not transmit light.
  - ⇒ Down the sensitivity setting or turn it off.





# 6.1.3. Paper feed work time

- Can be change in the range of 0 ~ 5.0 seconds.
- 0.5 seconds is default setting.

#### 6.1.4. Tri-suction

- Suction power
- The Suction power can be change in the range of 1~10.
- 5 is default setting.
- Down the Suction power is effective for double feeding.
- Up the Suction power is effective for feeding heavy paper.
- When set to 0, it does not suction.
- Press to switch to the automatic suction power adjustment mode.


#### ◆ Front blow power

- The Front blow power can be change in the range of  $1\sim10$ .
- 10 is default setting.
- Down the Front blow power is effective for paper skew.
- Up the Front blow power is effective for feeding


• The Side blow power can be change in the range of  $1\sim10$ .



- 5 is default setting.
- Down the Side blow power is effective for paper skew.
- Up the Side blow power is effective for feeding heavy paper and double feeding.
- · When set to 0, it does not blow.


#### 6.1.5. Table position after work

- When the switch is set to TOP, the feed table remains in the position where the previous job was finished.
- When the switch is set to BOTTOM, to make loading the next work easier, the feed table automatically moves back to the bottom dead position and stops.



#### 6.1.6. Press Conditions

- Pressurization direction
  - ALTERNATE is default setting.



- · Case of ALTERNATE.
  - ① Move the press roller from the current position to the opposite side.
  - 2 Repeat the process of ①.
- Case of ONE WAY.
  - ① Move the press roller from the current position to the opposite side.
  - ② If multifaceted control, Repeat the process of①.
    If multifaceted control is completed or not to select multifaceted control function, go to③.
  - 3 Eject paper
  - 4 Return the press roller to the initial position.

#### ◆Paper interval


CLOSE is default setting.

PAPER CLOSE
INTERVAL SEPARATE

- Case of CLOSE.
  - ① Cut the first paper.
  - 2 Immediately after cutting, feed the next paper and cut.
    - →The cutting speed becomes faster by closing the paper interval.
- Case of SPARATE.
  - ① Cut the first paper.
  - ② After cutting, the cutting paper is ejected first.
  - 3 After ejected, the next paper is fed and cut.
    - →Depending on the blade layout, can be avoid overlapping.
    - →Effective for risk of paper jam.
- ◆ Positional deviation correction by Pressurization direction




- Cutting position differs depending on the pressurization direction.
- Measure the value difference between when pressurization is applied from right to left and when pressurization is applied from left to right, and input half the difference.
- 0.006 is default setting.



# 6.1.7. Error setting

- ON is the default setting.
- Can be switched on and off.
- Depending on the workpiece, paper jam may be detected incorrectly.
   Turn OFF if frequent paper jams occur.




# 7.1.3. Stretch/Shrink adjustment


XThis method is effective only for multifaceted control.

\*The adjustment is effective for the position where the paper is cutting, not for the shape of Die board.


◆Case of print is gradually shifted to the left from the cutting position.




- ① Gradually shifts to the left, the print is shrinking.
- ② Measure the value of shrink and input a "-"value to shorten the pitch.



◆Case of print is gradually shifted to the right from the cutting position.




- ① Gradually shifts to the right, the print is stretching.
- ② Measure the value of stretch and input a "+"value to lengthen the pitch.




# 7.2. Respond for shift of depth direction


- Adjust the position of the Feed unit to respond with the shift in the depth direction.
- Use the pointer on the side of the Feed unit as a guide to adjust the Depth adjustment handle.
- ◆Case of print is shifted to the back of the cutting position.




- ① Measure the value of shift.
- ② Turn the Depth adjustment handle and slide the Feed unit forward by the value of the shift.






- · Adjust the tilt of the Feed guide to respond with the printing skew.




